

YARD SALE CHECKLIST

SUPPLIES YOU WILL NEED

- Sharpie or magic markers
- Poster board and/or yard sale signs
- Grocery bags for sales
- Packing material for fragile items
- Pre-made price stickers or printable stickers
- Tables and blankets to put items on
- Rope and hangers
- Baggies, quart, sandwich size, snack size
- Cash box and/or waist pouch
- Cash to make change
- Calculator/cell phone
- Extension cord for buyers to test electrical items
- Various sized boxes and/or bins for items that are grouped and priced the same
- Receipts – if you are having a fundraiser or a group yard sale

TWO WEEKS BEFORE the yard sale

- Set your yard sale date
- Set rain date
- Confirm place to hold yard sale, if not at your house
- Clear space in your home to organize items for sale
- Gather clothes and items to sell
- Start saving bags and packing material for day of yard sale

ONE WEEK BEFORE the yard sale

- Make sure items are clean and are working
- Organize items by category, ex. kitchen, family room, bathroom
- Put small items in baggies
- Price all items
- Make or buy signs to direct traffic to your yard sale
- Take pictures of items you want to feature
- List yard sale FREE on YardsaleTreasures.com

NIGHT BEFORE the yard sale

- Prepare any refreshments if you are selling them at the yard sale
- Gather bags and packing material for fragile items
- Set up rope for any hanging items
- Organize money for change
- Put sale items in selling area, (away from items not for sale)
- Put yard sale signs out

DAY OF the yard sale

- Brew coffee and prepare drinks and snacks (If having)
- Put items out in time for posted sale time
- Put eye catching and larger items close to the road for curb appeal
- OPEN ON TIME!
- Have fun!

AFTER the yard sale

- Remove all signs (Don't forget the street corner signs)
 - Take remaining items to a charity
 - Enjoy your clutter free space and full wallet!
